



BELMONT LAND USE OFFICE

The Planning Board consists of six members who are elected to the Board, one ex-officio member of the Board of Selectmen and three alternate members who are appointed by the Planning Board. With the exception of the ex-officio member, all members and alternates serve three-year terms.

The Zoning Board consists of five members who are elected to the Board and five alternate members who are appointed by the Zoning Board. All members and alternates serve three-year terms.

The Conservation Commission consists of six appointed members, one ex-officio member of the Board of Selectmen and three alternate members. All members and alternates are appointed by the Board of Selectmen and serve three-year terms.

The Heritage Commission consists of six members appointed by the Board of Selectmen and one ex-officio member of the Board of Selectmen. All members serve three-year terms.
