**Belmont Firefighters Respond to:** a reported building fire on Depot Rd at the Weeks Farm. Enroute companies were notified that dispatch was receiving many calls reporting a barn fire. The first company on scene was Belmont Engine one with Lieutenant Fred Greene in charge. Lt. Green immediately requested a second alarm assignment due to the size of the building and the amount of fire involvement. Engine one layed a supply line from the closest hydrant and placed the first attack line between the fire and the house that was 20ft from the barn. The residents of the house had not yet evacuated and were immediately removed by firefighters. Due to the advanced stage of the fire companies took up a defensive position and used Belmont Tower 1, ground monitor's and multiple 2 ½ hand lines to get the fire under control. There were no animals in the building but the barn was full with 2,000 bales of hay. The fire was original reported by a passerby. No firefighters or civilians were injured and the building is considered a complete loss. An excavator was brought in to assist firefighters with overhaul.
